About Air Ambulance NI

Air Ambulance NI is your local charity that provides the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) for Northern Ireland in partnership with Northern Ireland Ambulance Service. The service brings urgent medical assistance to anywhere in the province, operating seven days a week for twelve hours per day. This Doctor / Paramedic service brings clinical interventions to those whose lives are at serious



risk following significant trauma or medical emergency. Effectively the service brings pre-hospital emergency hospital care direct to the casualty.

Air Ambulance NI needs to raise £2.5m each year to sustain and develop the service.

Air Ambulance is vital is saving lives, brains and limbs.

Since the service commenced in July 2017, we have been tasked over 3,500 times, helping people like Barney Surgenor from Antrim.



While working on gutters Barry fell, receiving a serious head injury, thankfully after treatment at scene and transported to hospital Barney has made a full recovery. Barney's fiancé Pauline shares poignant memories from that day. Pauline said, "It was a day I'll not forget in a hurry. I had been looking after the grandchildren when a phone call came through to say Barney had had an accident at work. Barney runs an outdoor services company and was cleaning guttering at the time. I got to scene as fast as I could, but the helicopter was already taking off with Barney on board to be transferred to the Royal Victoria Hospital.

The consultant told me that Barney was in a critical condition with a skull fracture from his forehead right to the base of his neck and had three bleeds on the brain.

He was in hospital for 4 days though when he did get home, he was a different person. The bleeding to part of the brain had caused a change in his personality meaning that my usually chatty Barney was quiet and withdrawn. Thankfully, after a few weeks my Barney was back and incredibly in 6 weeks he was back to work!"

Air Ambulance NI Structure

JOB PURPOSE:

As a key member of a highly motivated and skilled team, you have a vital role in maximising income, awareness and charity profile to help deliver an annual income target upwards of £2.5m. You will build lasting and valuable relationships with supporters, companies, fundraising groups, volunteers and local media.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Contributing to the Air Ambulance NI Fundraising Strategy and budget development.
- 2. Develop, lead and deliver an agreed action plan for your area.
- 3. Build long term relationships to grow a network of inspired and engaged local communities supporting Air Ambulance NI in your own designated fundraising area. This will involve personally developing support from the community and corporate sectors, as well as fundraising support groups and focusing on high potential relationships.
- 4. Team Lead for at least one assigned income project.
- 5. Actively recruit support of Air Ambulance NI's membership programme.
- 6. Recruit and develop volunteer ambassadors to increase capacity and ensure cover across the province.
- 7. Develop local profile in the area through proactive networking and PR in local media.
- 8. Work closely with team members to maximise performance and support each other.
